Programms offered:

Practitioner Certificate in Logistics, Supply Chain & Operations Management, Level 3 (OFQUAL)

Admission Requirements

- To register for a certificate programme, a candidate must hold an NSSC or equivalent qualification, with a minimum score of 18 points in five (5) subjects on the NUST Evaluation Scale, including an E symbol in English and an E in Maths.
- Grade 10 with 5 years of industry experience, Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) to be considered.
- Applicants should also have internet access and a valid e-mail address

Professional Certificate in Supply Chain and Operations Management, Level 5 (OFQUAL)

Admission Requirements

- To register for a professional certificate programme, a candidate must hold an NSSC or equivalent qualification, with a minimum score of 22 points in five (5) subjects on the NUST Evaluation Scale, including an E symbol in English and a D in Maths.
- CILT UK/BIZZCO Level 3/4 or any other equivalent NQA Level 4 in logistics or a recognized qualification
- Applicants should also have internet access and a valid e-mail address

Advanced Professional Diploma in Supply Chain Networks, Level 6 (OFQUAL)

Admission Requirements

To qualify for admission to the advanced professional Diploma, a candidate must meet the following minimum requirements:

- CILT UK/BIZZCO Level 5 diploma or any other equivalent recognized NQA Level 5 in Logistics and Transport or recognized qualification
- Applicants should also have internet access and a valid e-mail address
